

New Multi-Use Pathway: Henderson Blvd.

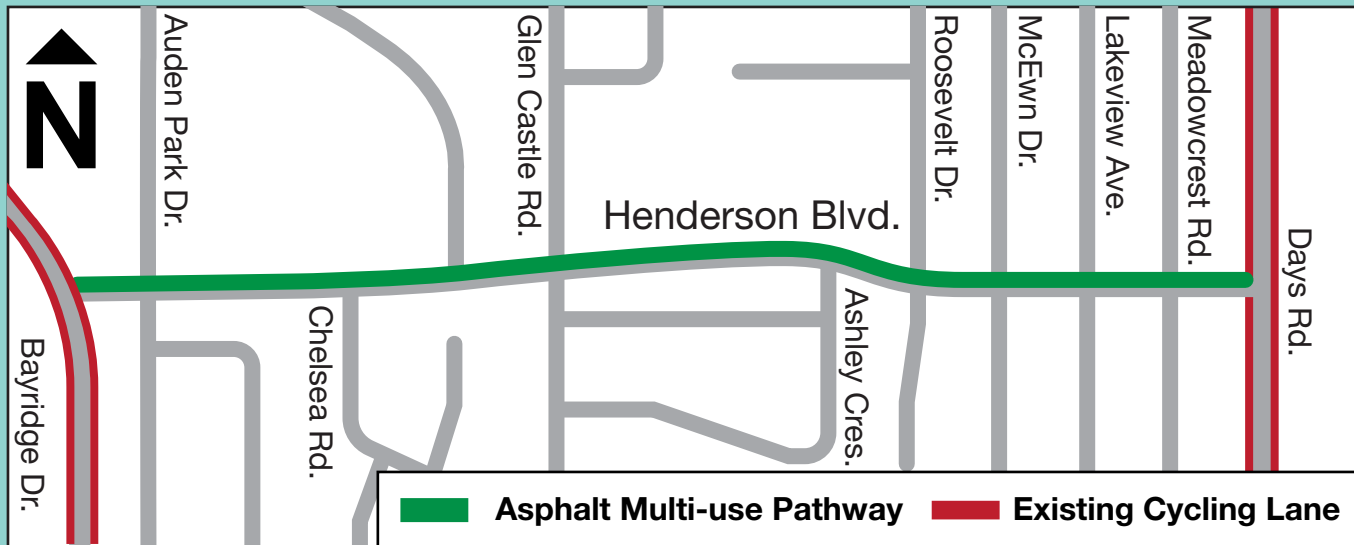
- Construction begins July 2021
- Planned to open October 2021

A new 3-metre asphalt multi-use pathway is being constructed on the north side of Henderson Boulevard. The new pathway will provide a direct connection to Jim Beattie Park and École J.R. Henderson Public School for pedestrians and cyclists.

This pathway will also connect Bayridge Drive to Days Road, which together form part of "Route 6", a city-wide route that was identified in the City's five-year Active Transportation Implementation Plan.
