Subject:	Approval of Local Distribution Rate Changes for Natural Gas

## **Executive Summary:**

This report is requesting an adjustment to local distribution rates for the natural gas utility for January 1, 2018. We are recommending the local distribution rate component of the bill, excluding Cap and Trade, increase by 2.5%. The total bill impact for a typical residential customer utilizing an average of 2,300 m<sup>3</sup> of natural gas total per year is an annual increase of \$11.04 or 1%.

#### **Recommendation:**

That Council approve:

- 1. The proposed Gas Rate changes effective January 1, 2018 as detailed in this report; and
- 2. By-Law Number 2017-XX A By-Law to Amend By-Law Number 2010-17 "A By-Law to Impose Gas Rates, as amended by By-Law 2013-18, and as amended by By-law 2015-28, and as amended by By-law 2017-21 (Exhibit A).

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## **Options/Discussion:**

This report details the proposed local distribution rate changes for the natural gas utility.

Gas local distribution costs consist of fixed and volumetric charge components for the operation, repair and maintenance of the gas works, and also a variable charge component for cap and trade greenhouse gas emissions compliance obligation costs.

On the customer's bill, the local distribution volumetric charges and the cap and trade charges are rolled together on the Delivery line.

The current gas local distribution costs charges, excluding the cap and trade charge component introduced in 2017, have not been increased since March 1, 2015.

The proposed local distribution costs change is specific to the local distribution volumetric block component rates. The cap and trade rate and the monthly fixed charges components are not affected by the proposed changes.

The commodity and transportation & storage charges that are treated as pass-through are also not affected by the proposed changes.

The following chart summarizes the current and the proposed January 1, 2018 Local Distribution Costs:

For a typical residential customer with 2300 m<sup>3</sup> per year consumption, the annualized total bill impact is an estimated \$11.04 increase for the year or 1%.
