# c) Report Received from the Housing and Homelessness Advisory Committee

To the Chair and Members of the Arts, Recreation and Community Policies Committee:

The Housing and Homelessness Advisory Committee reports and recommends as follows from the Housing and Homelessness Advisory Committee meeting held on December 14, 2017:

#### i. Homeless Services Review Update & Recommendations

**That** the Arts, Recreation and Community Policies Committee recommends as follows:

**That** Council direct city staff to continue to implement the Housing First service delivery model through the delivery of the following four core services identified in the 10-Year Municipal Housing & Homelessness Plan: Prevention/Diversion, Homelessness Prevention, Housing Assistance/Emergency Shelters and Housing First/Rapid Re-Housing; and

**That** Council direct city staff to work with the Community Homelessness Prevention Initiative (CHPI) funded Housing & Homelessness Service providers to provide daytime services for vulnerable women for the term while Elizabeth Fry Kingston continues to operate as an emergency shelter; and

**That** Council direct city staff to work with CHPI funded Housing & Homelessness Service providers to provide a short term Housing Liaison Worker to develop a communication strategy and housing resource material inventory for the rural area; and

**That** Council direct city staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to seek Housing First/Rapid Re-Housing (HF/RRH) services to replace the services currently provided by Addictions and Mental Health Services – KFLA; it being understood that the RFP seeking HF/RRH services reduce the service capacity by removing one Assessment Worker to allow the Service Manager to adequately resource another program area where gaps have been identified in the system.
