


#### **About The Project**

**Project Enhancement preferences** 

Based on the results of public engagement and approval by City Council, project enhancements may be considered, subject to the ability to secure diverse sources of funding.

Extending the walkway to the light house and providing a lookout area

Widening the walkway and creating an enhanced entry area including upgraded public realm design elements

Enhanced swimming space amenities

#### **The Promenade Project**

The Confederation Basin Promenade Project proposes a new accessible walkway and public space experience built on the existing stone breakwall that shelters Flora MacDonald Confederation Basin.

The Council approved budget for the Project is \$2.695M which includes:

- Connection to Battery Park;
- The Promenade Walkway including lighting;
- Lookout Area at the bend;
- Water's Edge Access Amenity with restricted boat access;
- Seating Opportunities; and
- Artful elements.






