

## Parks Development – Jade Avenue Park Public engagement summary

Open house: March 6, 2019

Get Involved Kingston online survey: March 6 – 28, 2019

The proposed park design for Jade Avenue Park includes accessible pathways, a playground with swings and a play structure, seating, tree planting and landscaping, and open space suitable for play or community operated rink.

Two proposed conceptual park designs and 3 playground equipment options were presented at the public open house held March 6, and available online on the City's Get Involved website at <a href="mailto:getinvolved.cityofkingston.ca">getinvolved.cityofkingston.ca</a>

In accordance with Ontario Regulation 191/11, accessibility feedback related to the proposed improvements was received by Laurie Paquin.

## Summary of feedback collected

- Of the two conceptual design options Concept A was preferred. Concept A was more linear in nature, with straight pathways. There was also strong support for Concept B.
- Of the playground equipment options Option 2 was preferred. Option 2 provided a linear platform play experience.
- Feedback provided highlighted a desire for a future community-operated skating rink, additional tree planting and more seating.
