**Business**

**a. Update - Kingston Commemoration Policy (POL-37)**

Councillor Stroud made reference to the previously prepared reports related to the proposed valour district. He spoke to the importance of sharing diversely themed stories.

The Chair afforded members of the public with an opportunity to provide comment.

Mr. Dixon commented that the Report is well thought out. He commented that he is in agreement with staff that this matter should be revisited moving forward.

Councillor Stroud suggested that Cultural Services should conduct additional consultation regarding this matter in the future.

Councillor Boehme indicated that he was in agreement with Councillor Stroud.

Councillor Hutchison commented that the North King's Town Secondary Plan Working Group is examining the stories of the cultural groups and hardworking people of the area. He stated that the position proposed by staff in the Report is reasonable.

Councillor Stroud sought further information regarding insurance costs for user groups. Mr. Unsworth provided the Committee with additional information regarding insurance options. Councillor Stroud commented that the insurance requirements of the Policy should be outlined similar to the Community Gardens Operations & Development Policy.

Councillor Boehme requested that staff update Schedule A to reflect the new rink at Moly McGlynn Park. Mr. Unsworth responded that the exhibit will be updated when a major facility is added in the future.

The Chair afforded members of the public with an opportunity to provide comment.

Mr. Dixon commented that ensuring that outdoors rinks are accessible is important. He questioned if there is an outdoor rink in each district. He suggested that Belle Park could be used as a site for outdoor hockey tournaments.

Mr. Unsworth stated that information regarding outdoors rinks is included on the City of Kingston website. He indicated that excessive water usage at Belle Park could be an issue. He spoke further to the locations of outdoors rinks in Kingston.
