Subject: Annual Amendment to Fees and Charges By-Law 2005-10

Executive Summary:

The *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes a municipality to impose fees for services. Fees charged to users for various services are a primary source of municipal revenue, representing approximately 14% of the City's total municipal revenue budget. In that regard, the City's policy dictates that fees and charges be reviewed and adjusted annually by the Consumer Price Core Index of the third quarter of the prior year plus 1% for capital purposes, where feasible, or by an amount that will recover, at a minimum, respective service, administration and capital costs. Financial Services works with departments to review annually, as part of the budget process, all fees and charges to ensure that they are being applied in accordance with policy and strategic direction. An amendment to the by-law is recommended to Council to reflect the annual changes.

In most cases, services that have fees associated with them are also subsidized in various proportions by taxation revenues and therefore it is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis and in conjunction with a review of respective service costs to ensure that the proportion of user fees and taxation subsidy is maintained. If fees are not adjusted appropriately, the result will be increased pressure on tax increases to subsidize the costs of providing the service.

Recommendation:

That the by-law attached as Exhibit A to Report Number 19-012 be presented to Council for all three readings to amend By-Law Number 2005-10, "A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by the Corporation of the City of Kingston", as amended, in order to establish fees and charges for 2019.

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Options/Discussion:

By-Law Number 2005-10, "A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by the Corporation of the City of Kingston", as amended, provides authorization in a consolidated fashion for the purposes of establishing fees and charges in a fiscal year. The by-law allows for fees and charges to be adjusted annually, on January 1, as approved by Council, as follows:

- By the Consumer Price Core Index of the third quarter of the prior year plus 1% for capital purposes, where feasible;
- By a cumulative adjustment for past years where the fee is not adjusted by the Consumer Price Index in one year;
- By an amount that will recover, at a minimum, respective service, administration and capital costs, as well as costs for any other purpose in any amount permitted under applicable law.

In Canada, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) is the price index most commonly used to calculate inflation. Because of this, CPI has become the accepted measure for the rate of inflation in Canada. Despite the common use of the term CPI to mean a single measure of inflation, there is more than one way to use the CPI to calculate inflation. The Consumer Price Core Index is the escalator prescribed in this By-Law to be used as a proxy for inflation estimates. This indicator is based on the average of three specific measures of core inflation and removes from the calculations some of the goods and services which are the most volatile such as gasoline and fuel oil.

The By-Law provides for adjustments to fees for services, in comparison to the related costs of providing the respective service, which becomes an important strategy in maintaining appropriate levels of cost recovery. Services that have fees associated with them are, in most cases, also subsidized in various proportions by taxation revenues and, therefore, it is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis and in conjunction with a review of respective service costs to ensure that the proportion of user fees and taxation subsidy is maintained. In addition to taxation and provincial grant revenues, fees charged to users for various services are a primary source of municipal revenue, representing approximately 14% of the City's total municipal revenue budget.

The Consumer Price Core Index average was 2% as at the end of the third quarter of 2018. The Bank of Canada projection for inflation over the next fiscal year and into the longer term is estimated to average 2%. Because of this, in many cases where fee adjustments have been made to account for inflation, fee increases represent up to 2% escalation, in addition to the 1% for capital purposes, in order to reflect an average inflationary adjustment required to cover total expected costs for the service for 2019, as permitted by the By-law.

Because the review and setting of fees is a process that is carried out in conjunction with other planning and budgeting activities, normally information with respect to proposed changes to fees and charges would be brought forward to Council during budget deliberations in the fall of the year. However, due to the timing of the election and the resulting delay in budget deliberations until the new year, the need to maintain consistent policy and practice and in order avoid the

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loss of normal fee increases for the first quarter of 2019, it is necessary to address this By-law amendment now in order to have the authority in place to post and implement these fees and charges for January 1st. These fee adjustments have been considered as part of the funding for various programs in preparation of the 2019 operating budget.

For the majority of recommended fees, an increase of up to 2% escalation plus 1% for capital purposes has been applied, effective January 1, 2019. Some fees have been adjusted slightly more or less than this amount as a result of rounding in order to maintain even dollar amounts after tax for ease of cash handling or to maintain amounts that support the constraints of respective cash collection equipment.

For ease of review, the section references below provide further detail and explanation for fee changes detailed on Exhibit A to Report Number 19-012 where changes are other than the annual inflationary adjustments noted above. The majority of these changes reflect one of the following strategies:

- Maintaining fee levels where the charge is currently sufficient to cover the full cost of the good or service;
- Setting fees to reflect an appropriate market rate based on market analysis;
- Minimizing fee increases to encourage increased use of a good or service;
- Setting fees to support harmonization efforts or consistency of fees for similar services across different departments;
- Setting fees in accordance with Council-approved strategies
- · Addition of new fees.

Other Fees & Charges:

Clerk's Department

- No fee change to Document Searches (pursuant to MFIPPA) and Affidavits for Non-Profit Housing Matters. Remains the same in accordance with relevant legislation.
- The fee for Photocopies of Documents, including by-laws, stayed the same as it is sufficient to recover costs.
- New fees added to request the attendance of fence-viewers and for remuneration to be paid to the fence viewers in accordance with the Line Fences Act.

Grand Theatre:

 Non Performance Lease Rate for Baby Grand for Kingston Community Groups increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.

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- Security Commissionaire fee increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure in order to recover increased cost.
- Ticket office charges increased by slightly more than or less than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.

Recreation & Leisure:

A number of recreation fees have been adjusted by an amount that differs from an inflationary measure for cash handling purposes and to support fee harmonization efforts.

Pool or Gym Membership (Cardio, Weight Room, Gym)

- Some fees increased by more than an inflationary measure due to increased wage costs as a result of legislative changes.
- Child(ren) & Parent(s) rates for 1 visit, 6 Month and Annual fees increased more than an inflationary measure in order to reflect an appropriate fee structure in proportion to adult rates.

Aquafit (Aquafit, Sauna)

• Some fees increased slightly more or less than an inflationary measure in order to phase in the harmonization of these fees to the wellness program fees by 2020.

Training

 Most fees increased less than an inflationary measure to encourage use and to remain competitive.

Wellness Membership (Artillery Park – Pool, Gym, Cardio/ Weight Room) (INVISTA Fitness Centre – Public Skating, Fitness Classes, Weight/Cardio Equipment)

 Most fees were adjusted slightly more or less than an inflationary measure in order to reflect an appropriate fee structure in proportion to adult rates and to harmonize with other fee structures.

Startup Membership Incentive Discount

 Fees were adjusted slightly more or less than an inflationary measure to harmonize with wellness rates.

All Inclusive Annual Membership - Fit Pass

• Fees were adjusted slightly more or less than an inflationary measure to encourage use and to harmonize with other fees.

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All Inclusive 6 Month Membership - SPARK

 Added new SPARK 6 month membership (Subsidy Program for Affordable Recreation Kingston)

– effective January 1, 2019.

Tomlinson Aqua Park

 Drop in evening pass fees and camp fees per visit remained the same to encourage use and to remain competitive.

Other Fees

- No change to some fees for ease of cash management and advertising.
- Increased Shower (per visit) and skate rental for child, senior/youth and adult by more than an inflationary measure to reflect multi-year increase for ease of cash management.
- Added Halloween skate or swim booklets, 10 visits child.

Events & Programs

- Some fees remained the same or increased less than an inflationary measure in order to encourage use and remain cost competitive. Where applicable, some fees were adjusted by more than an inflationary measure to reflect increased student wage costs as a result of legislative changes or to reflect rounding for cash management purposes.
- Removed the following fees no longer required:
 - Camp grass Creek / Camp Cat 4 day week
 - Camp Theatre 9 days
 - Camp Extended Supervision (9 days, 5 days, 4 days)

Artillery Park Programs - Fees Effective April 1

- Increased the following fees by more than an inflationary measure due to increasing program costs:
 - Bronze Cross
 - National Lifequard Service
 - Standard First Aid
 - Standard First Aid Recertification
- Changed the following age ranges to be:
 - Swim Lessons, Youth Level 9-10 from 8-10
 - Swim Lessons, Youth Level 5-8 from 5-7
 - Low Ratio Swim Lessons, Youth Level 5-8 from 5-7
 - Low Ratio Swim Lessons. Youth Level 9-10 from 8-10

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Springer Market Square

- Removed the following fees as rates no longer apply:
 - Basic Lease Rate for 8 X 8 Stalls 79 to 100.
 - Daily Rates for Sunday Produce, Sunday Craft, Additional Stall, Casual 8 X 8 Stall and Sunday 8 X 8 Stall.

Rental Rates:

 Artillery Park Aquatic Centre Increased pool rental rates by more than an inflationary measure to accommodate increased aquatic staffing costs.

Rideau Heights Community Centre

Added new fee for Half Gymnasium

City Hall

 Removed the Lakeview Room rental fee, as this space is no longer available for bookings and added a rental fee for the Stationview Room.

Rideaucrest Catering:

 Many fees remained the same as they are sufficient to recover respective costs and, due to the size of the fees, will only be adjusted periodically by a multi-year increase.

Parks:

- Restructured park rental fee categories to reflect more appropriate levels of attendees.
- New annual rate for Non vehicle self-contained food and beverage as new policy allows individuals to set up a non-vehicle (i.e. shipping container) as a food truck.

Sports Fields:

 Increased fees for ball diamonds and soccer fields by 20% to reflect ongoing phase in of fee adjustments as originally identified in the Council endorsed Sports Field Management Policy (ARCP-09-038).

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Arenas:

- Changed Summer Ice Non-Prime "all day" to "8 a.m." (or 8:30 a.m. on rinks booked on the ½ hour) to align with the updated Ice Allocation policy.
- Regular Ice all four "Prime" ice descriptions changed "close" to "12 a.m." to align with the updated Ice Allocation policy.

Belle Park:

Driving Range Seasonal Memberships and Other Services

 Some fees increased by less than an inflationary measure for simplified cash handling.

Marinas:

- Removed Storage rates for Summer (per foot) and Emergency Yard Storage (per foot per day) as this service is no longer being provided due to space constraints.
- A new fee for Crawford Wharf Cruise Ships was added.

Airport:

Surcharges

 No change to AVGAS Fuel Surcharge (per litre) and Turbine Fuel Surcharge (per litre). Fees remain the same as they are sufficient to recover respective costs.

Motor Vehicle Parking Fees

 Short-Term increased by slightly less than an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.

Passenger Facility Fee (Per Departing Passenger)

 Rate increased by greater than an inflationary measure to be comparable with other similar sized airports.

Planning:

On November 1, 2018, a public meeting was held at Planning Committee regarding Planning Act application fees for 2019. Report Number PC-18-069 provides a detailed overview of the background and the work that was completed by Planning staff and Watson & Associates Economists Ltd.

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In addition to implementing a new fee for pre-application, which was previously a free service provided by the City, the following fees have increased by more than an inflationary measure to ensure sufficient recovery of costs:

- Zoning By-law Amendment fee for developments in excess of 3,000 square metres of floor area or 50 dwelling units;
- Site Plan Control Modification application where an amending agreement is required;
- Site Plan Control Request for Security Reduction/Release; and
- Committee of Adjustment Non-technical Consents.

Additional terms and conditions of fees have also been added to the fees and charges schedule.

Engineering:

Development Application Review

 No change to Plan of Subdivision deposits as they are currently at an appropriate level.

Patio Leasing/License

• Rain Screen Fee (per square meter) remained the same as it is sufficient to recover respective costs.

Parking:

Parking rates remain in accordance with EITP Report 16-017 (November 1, 2016) which provided for a new pricing framework to ensure parking management objectives for the city were met, including maintaining the long-term health of the Parking Reserve Fund. Parking rates included in the 2019 Fees and Charges By-Law, Schedule A continue to reflect approved recommendations as follows:

On Street Parking - Meters and Pay and Display

- No increase to On Street Parking Meters and Pay and Display rates which were added per EITP Report 17-155 (June 2018). Current fees are sufficient to recover respective costs.
 - Institutional area: Schedule A-1, Zones B & K (Part Two), D, F, J; Schedule A-2, Zones A, B (Part Two)
 - Institutional Area: Accessible Parking Meters

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- Tour Bus Parking Meter Zones
- Zone E Lower George Street and City Park Inner Road
- Increases greater than an inflationary measure were applied to the following in accordance with EITP-16-017:
 - Downtown/Williamsville (high demand): Schedule A-1, Zone A (Part One):
 \$1.50 to \$2.00
 - Downtown/Williamsville (low demand): Schedule A-1, Zones B (Part One),
 and I; Schedule A-2, Zones C and H: \$1.00 to \$1.50
 - Downtown/Williamsville (high/low demand): Accessible Parking Meters:
 \$1.00 to \$1.50

On Street Parking - Residential On Street Permits

 No increase to Residential on Street Permit rates which were added per EITP Report 17-155 (June 2018). Current fees are sufficient to recover respective costs.

Hourly Rates by Lot

- Increases from \$1 to \$1.50 for the following lots in accordance with EITP-16-017:
 - Angrove Lot
 - Armstrong Memorial Lot
 - Barrack Lot
 - Drury Lot
 - Frontenac Lot
 - Gorsline Lot
 - King/Queen Lot
 - Kingston Frontenac Public Library Lot
 - McKee Memorial Lot
 - Ordnance Lot
 - Pump House Lot (Steam Museum)
 - Springer Memorial Lot

Other Rates by Lot

- No increase for Ontario/Brock Lot as per Council Report Number 17-265
- No increase for Rideaucrest Lot however this rate is under review with changes expected for Spring 2019 to accommodate removal of the existing gate and increased usage on weekdays.

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Event Rates by Lot

- Increases for the following lots in accordance with EITP-16-017:
 - Anglin Lot: \$4 to \$5
 - Lower Robert Bruce Memorial Lot: \$3 to \$4
 - Upper Robert Bruce Memorial Lot: \$3 to \$4

Parking Space Rental Fees

• Increased certain fees slightly more or less than an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.

Transit:

Transit rates have remained the same in accordance with the Kingston Transit Business Plan as outlined in Council Report Number 16-304.

Building & Licensing:

Building Permit and Related Fees

- The following fees were not increased, or increased less than an inflationary measure as they are sufficient to recover respective costs:
 - Conditional Permit Fee Minimum
 - Expedited Plan Review (per hour)
 - Alternative Solution Proposal (per hour) and Minimum
 - Preliminary Project Review and Revisions to an Issued Permit (per hour)
 - Construction Prior to Permit Issuance and Minimum
 - Photocopies or printing of documents including Freedom of Information, per side, plus search fees
 - Photocopies or printing of documents colour
- The following increased by more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes:
 - Property Standards Application for Appeals
 - Sign Permit "A" Frame or Sandwich Board, per year
 - Sign Permit, Boulevard Sign, per week
 - Property Standards/Yards Re-Inspection Fee (after first inspection to confirm compliance of any order)

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Animal Registration

No fee changes to encourage licensing activities.

Other Animal Related Fees

 No fee changes to most fees where current fees continue to be appropriate to recover respective costs.

Application for Noise Exemption

As part of a comprehensive review of the licensing and enforcement fees an activity based model was created to look at each fee type to determine the overall cost to the Corporation associated with each service. The activity based model determined that the City was not recovering costs related to noise by-law exemption requests. Fee increases for noise exemption applications (\$127.00 to \$300.00) and for re-applications (\$79.50 to \$188.00) will enable the City to increase its recovery of costs from 27% to approximately 65% for these services.

Business Licences

- No changes to selected Alarm Monitoring fees in accordance with Administrative Policies Committee Report AP-17-037 (November 9, 2017) which outlined proposed changes to alarm installation and alarm monitoring as regulated under the Business Licensing By-Law.
- Some fees increased slightly more or less than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.

Solid Waste:

A number of fees in Solid Waste have remained the same or been adjusted by less than an inflationary measure where it will encourage proper disposal:

- Garbage no change to Garbage Bag Tags.
- Source Separated Organics Schools no change to cost per student per year for collecting organics (elementary and secondary schools).
- Industrial, Commercial & Institutional Users of Municipal and Contracted Compost Sites no change to Compostable Yard Waste and Brush (per tonne).

Disposal Fees

 No change to disposal fees for aerosol containers, fluorescent lamps, oil per litre, miscellaneous organics and petroleum distillates/light fuels as fees are sufficient to cover respective costs of disposal.

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Recycling

 Reduced the fee for recycling boxes to reflect a lower cost negotiated in a new contract. No change to Mobile Recycling Trailer Delivery and Collection as fee is sufficient to recover respective cost.

Fire and Rescue:

False Alarms, Unauthorized Burning and Non-Resident Responses

 No changes as fees are currently aligned with Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) rates.

Live Fire Training

No changes as fees continue to recover respective costs.

Non-Live Fire Training

No changes as fees continue to recover respective costs.

Existing Policy/By Law:

By-Law 2005-10 "A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by the Corporation of the City of Kingston", as amended.

- Floor area of the proposed work is to be measured to the outer face of exterior walls (excluding residential attached garages) and to the centre line of party walls, firewalls or demising walls.
- In the case of interior finishes, alterations or renovations, area of proposed work is the actual space receiving the work, e.g. tenant suite.
- Mechanical penthouses and floors, mezzanines, lofts, habitable attics and interior balconies are to be included in all floor area calculations.
- Except for interconnected floor spaces, no deductions are made for openings within the floor area (e.g. stairs, elevators, escalators, shafts, ducts, etc.).
- Unfinished basements for single detached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings and townhouses are not included in the floor area.
- Where Demolition of partitions or alterations to existing ceilings are part of an alteration or renovation Permit, no additional charge is applicable.
- Corridors, lobbies, washrooms, lounges, etc. are to be included and classified according to the major occupancy for the floor area on which they are located.
- The occupancy categories in this Schedule correspond with the major occupancy classifications in the Ontario Building Code. For multiple occupancy floor areas, the Permit fees for each of the applicable occupancy categories may be used, except where an occupancy category is less than 10% of the floor area.
