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The consent of Council is requested for the **withdrawal** of The Committee of Whole “Closed Meeting” item 1 a):

1. a) Litigation or potential litigation, including matters before administrative tribunals, affecting the municipality or local board; and advice that is subject to solicitor-client privilege, including communications necessary for that purpose – 268 Victoria Street

At the request of the mover, Councillor Doherty and the seconder, Councillor Neill, the consent of Council is requested for the **withdrawal** of New Motion 1.

**Whereas** Bill 66, Restoring Ontario’s Competitiveness Act is currently under consideration by the Legislative Assembly of Ontario; and

**Whereas** Schedule 10 of Bill 66 amends the Planning Act to add a new section 34.1, which allows local municipalities to pass “open-for business by-laws” with approval in writing by the Minister; and

**Whereas** the “open-for-business by-law” would override critical legal requirements to protect water, natural heritage, farmland and human health; and

**Whereas** these by-laws would take precedence over municipal official plans; and

**Whereas** no public notice or hearing is required prior to passing an open-for-business planning by-law; and

**Whereas** development approval by the Minister under the open-for-business by-law will not be subject to site plan control application and there will be no option to appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal;

**Therefore Be It Resolved That** if Bill 66 becomes law, this Council will only submit for approval under Schedule 10 developments that pose no risk to the environment and have full support from the public.
