Subject: Award of Contract – 2020 Model Year, Tandem Axle, Dual

Stream, Rear Loading Refuse Packer

### **Executive Summary:**

Staff issued a request for proposals (RFP F31-TIS-TS-FL-2019-07) for the purchase of one 2020 model year tandem axle, dual stream, rear loading refuse packer. This unit is a replacement for an existing refuse packer that has fulfilled lifecycle expectations.

Two proposals were received in response to the RFP. One of the proposals was rejected and not evaluated because it did not meet the required specifications.

Council approval is required because less than three proposals were received.

#### Recommendation:

**That** Mayor and Clerk be authorized to enter into a contract, in a form satisfactory to the Director of Legal Services, with Francis Canada Truck Centre Inc. for the purchase of one 2020 model year tandem axle, dual stream, rear loading, refuse packer (F31-TIS-TS-FL-2019-07), for the total purchase price of \$264,254 plus applicable taxes.

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# **Options/Discussion:**

Staff issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) on behalf of the Solid Waste Division for the purchase of one 2020 model year tandem axle, dual stream, rear loading refuse packer. This unit is a replacement for an existing refuse packer that has fulfilled lifecycle expectations. The submission was evaluated using the following criteria:

- Pricing and Related Costs 40%
- Specification Compliant 35%
- Warranty 10%
- Delivery 10%
- Accessibility Standards for Customer Service, Ontario Regulation 429/7 5%

Two proposals were received in response to the RFP. The proposal submitted by FST Canada Inc. operating as Joe Johnson Equipment was rejected and not evaluated because it did not meet the required specifications.

The proposal submitted by Francis Canada Truck Centre Inc. complied with all specifications requested in the RFP and the pricing and related costs are within approved budget. Staff recommends entering into a contract with Francis Canada Truck Centre Inc. for the purchase of one 2020 model year tandem axle, dual stream, rear loading, refuse packer for the total purchase price and related costs of \$264,254 plus applicable taxes.

A rear loading refuse packer is a very specialized piece of equipment that is widely used by municipalities that operate split-stream collection systems. There are a limited number of manufacturers that provide this type of equipment so a limited response to an RFP of this nature is not unusual.

The Solid Waste Division is currently operating nine similar units within their fleet. The truck is expected to be in service in the fourth quarter of 2019.
