Subject: Award of Contract – Road Rehabilitation Various Locations

Executive Summary:

The Engineering Department issued a tender for road rehabilitation work as part of the City's continued efforts to rehabilitate aging roads within the city. Two bids were received for Contract ENG-2019-04 Road Rehabilitation Various Locations. In accordance with the City's Purchasing Policy, Council approval is required when fewer than three bids are received. The award of this tender is time sensitive to enable the completion of the work during the construction season.

Recommendation:

That Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to enter into a contract, in a form satisfactory to the Director of Legal Services, with Kiley Paving Ltd. for the Tender ENG-2019-04 Road Rehabilitation Various Locations, in the amount of \$466,459.60 plus applicable taxes.

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Options/Discussion:

Staff recently tendered for construction work for the rehabilitation of a variety of local roads throughout the city. Contract ENG-2019-04 is one of two capital projects tendered in 2019 specifically focused on the rehabilitation of local roads. The second capital rehabilitation project tendered in 2019 is ENG-2019-08, which is the subject of Council Report Number 19-205. The work included in both tenders was identified in [Report 19-133](#) Council Strategic Priorities, and is further detailed in Exhibit A - 2019 Local Road Rehabilitation Projects. As previously committed, staff will present road projects for 2020-2022 for Council consideration during the 2020 budget process.

On Wednesday, June 19, 2019, two bids were received in response to the Request for Tender ENG-2019-04.

- Kiley Paving Ltd. \$466,459.60
- Coco Paving Inc. \$496,690.00

Prices do not include applicable taxes.

Kiley Paving is a reputable contractor that has completed contracts for the City in the past. The bid received from Kiley Paving is within the amount budgeted by the City for the completion of this work. As only two bids were received, Council approval is required to execute the contract.

This work supports Council's priority to improve walkability, roads, and transportation. The award of this tender is time sensitive due to the short construction season and to enable completion of this work.
