Subject:	Professional Engineering Services for Stormwater System Improvements on King Street East (Place D'Armes to Anglin Bay)	

Executive Summary:

The City of Kingston recently completed an evaluation of proposals received in response to Request for Proposal (RFP) F31-EN-2019-10 for Professional Engineering Services for Stormwater System Improvements on King Street East (Place D'Armes to Anglin Bay). Two proposals were received by the City of Kingston and, in accordance with the City's Purchasing Policy, the approval of Council is required in order to execute the contract. The evaluation of the proposals was conducted by staff from the Engineering Services Department, in accordance with the evaluation criteria and scoring system provided in the RFP document. The proposal provided by J.L. Richards & Associates Limited met all requirements, received the highest score, and provided costs which were found to be reasonable and within budget; therefore, staff recommend that the contract for Professional Engineering Services for Stormwater System Improvements on King Street East (Place D'Armes to Anglin Bay) be awarded to J.L. Richards & Associates Limited.

Recommendation:

That Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to enter into a contract, in a form satisfactory to the Director of Legal Services, with J.L. Richards & Associates Limited for Professional Engineering Services for Stormwater System Improvements on King Street East (Place D'Armes to Anglin Bay).

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Options/Discussion:

The objective of this project is to improve drainage at the downstream end of the King Street East storm sewer system (currently undersized) and the overland stormwater flow path from Place D'Armes to Anglin Bay. This area experiences seasonal flooding that has increased in frequency and intensity over the years, particularly at the Frontenac Village Condo (1 Place D'Armes), which has a parking garage entrance at the low point of the road. Challenges with this project include: engineered shoring system required for pipe installation due to weak soils and narrow corridor, treatment/disposal for soil and groundwater impacted by past industrial use, excavation and active dewatering directly adjacent to Anglin Bay seawall, archaeological potential, modification to the sheet pile seawall for new stormwater outfall, possible provincial/federal regulatory approvals.

On Wednesday, July 31, 2019, two bids were received in response to Request for Proposal F31-EN-2019-10 as follows:

J.L. Richards & Associates Limited is a reputable engineering consultant that has completed contracts for the City in the past. The bid received from J.L. Richards & Associates Limited is within the amount budgeted by the City for the completion of this work.
