#### **Council Strategic Plan Alignment:**

#### **Executive Summary:**

The *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes a municipality to impose fees for services. Fees charged to users for various services are a primary source of municipal revenue, representing approximately 15% of the City's total municipal revenue budget. In most cases, services that have fees associated with them are also subsidized in various proportions by taxation revenues and therefore it is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis and in conjunction with a review of respective service costs to ensure that the proportion of user fees and taxation subsidy is maintained. If fees are not adjusted appropriately, the result will be increased pressure on tax increases to subsidize the costs of providing the service.

In that regard, the City's policy dictates that fees and charges be reviewed and adjusted annually by the Consumer Price Core Index of the third quarter of the prior year plus 1% for capital purposes, where feasible, or by an amount that will recover, at a minimum, respective service, administration and capital costs.

As part of the annual budget process Financial Services reviews, in conjunction with City departments, all fees and charges to ensure that they are being applied in accordance with

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policy and strategic direction. Fee changes will be incorporated into the draft 2021 operating budget. An amendment to the By-Law is being recommended to Council to reflect the annual changes.

In light of COVID-19 and additional pressures that it has created on the most vulnerable population in the community, City staff are proposing a new approach through the fees and charges by law to increase access to people with lower incomes. In order to continue to support more access and encourage more physical activities for people with lower incomes, staff are recommending that as a pilot year, all recreation services that have unlimited participation such as gym fitness memberships, open skating and swimming, etc. be provided at no cost for all individuals that qualify for the Municipal Financial Assistance Program (MFAP). Typically, Ontario Works clients, Ontario Disability Support Program clients and low-income working individuals qualify for MFAP. As these programs are open and do not have limited numbers, except for COVID-19 restrictions, staff are not anticipating that there will be significant impacts on revenues. Furthermore, the City will continue to provide financial assistance through the Subsidy Program for Affordable Recreation in Kingston (SPARK) to support access to other programs that have limited registration such as swimming classes, fitness classes and aquafit classes. The annual \$117k allocated to the SPARK program will be able to reach more individuals/families in the community that qualify through the Municipal Fee Assistance Program (MFAP) process.

#### **Recommendation:**

**That** a by-law be presented to Council for all three readings to amend By-Law Number 2005-10, "A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by The Corporation of the City of Kingston", as amended, attached as Exhibit A to Report Number 21-025, in order to establish fees and charges for the 2021 fiscal year.

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# **Options/Discussion:**

By-Law Number 2005-10, "A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by The Corporation of the City of Kingston", as amended, provides authorization in a consolidated fashion for the purposes of establishing fees and charges in a fiscal year. The By-Law allows for fees and charges to be adjusted annually, on January 1, as approved by Council, as follows:

- By the Consumer Price Core Index of the third quarter of the prior year plus 1% for capital purposes, where feasible;
- By a cumulative adjustment for past years where the fee is not adjusted by the Consumer Price Index in one year; and
- By an amount that will recover, at a minimum, respective service, administration and capital costs, as well as costs for any other purpose in any amount permitted under applicable law.

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is the accepted measure for the rate of inflation in Canada. Despite the common use of the term CPI to mean a single measure of inflation, there is more than one way to use the CPI to calculate inflation. The Consumer Price Core Index is the escalator prescribed in this By-Law to be used as a proxy for inflation estimates. This indicator is based on the average of three specific measures of core inflation used by the Bank of Canada in order to filter out volatile price movements that can be caused by factors specific to certain components.

The By-Law provides for adjustments to fees for services, in comparison to the related costs of providing the respective service, which becomes an important strategy in maintaining appropriate levels of cost recovery. Services that have fees associated with them are, in most cases, are also subsidized in various proportions by taxation revenues and therefore it is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis and in conjunction with a review of respective service costs to ensure that the proportion of user fees and taxation subsidy is maintained. In addition to taxation and provincial grant revenues, fees charged to users for various services are a primary source of municipal revenue, representing approximately 15% of the City's total annual municipal revenue budget.

The Consumer Price Core Index average was 1.7% as at the end of the third quarter of 2020 and the Bank of Canada continues to utilize fiscal policy that targets inflation at 2%. In cases where fee adjustments have been made to account for inflation, fee increases represent up to 2% escalation, in addition to the 1% for capital purposes, in order to reflect an average inflationary adjustment required to cover total expected costs of services in 2021, as permitted by the By-Law.

For the majority of recommended fees, an increase of up to 2% escalation plus 1% for capital purposes has been applied, effective January 1, 2021. Some fees have been adjusted slightly more or less than this amount as a result of rounding in order to maintain even dollar amounts

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after tax for ease of cash handling or to maintain amounts that support the constraints of respective cash collection equipment.

For ease of review, the section references below provide further detail and explanation for fee changes detailed on Exhibit A to Council Report Number 21-025 where changes are other than the annual inflationary adjustments noted above. The majority of these changes reflect one of the following strategies:

- Maintaining fee levels where the charge is currently sufficient to cover the full cost of the good or service;
- Setting fees to reflect an appropriate market rate based on market analysis;
- Minimizing fee increases to encourage increased use of a good or service;
- Setting fees to support harmonization efforts or consistency of fees for similar services across different departments;
- Setting fees in accordance with Council-approved strategies;
- Addition of new fees, as required;
- Providing free access to gym memberships, open pool swims, and open public skating for those qualifying for the Municipal Fee Assistance Program.

#### **Other Fees & Charges**

#### **Finance and Clerk's Departments**

- No change to fees that are established in accordance with relevant legislation or where fees are sufficient to recover costs:
  - Affidavits for Non-Profit Housing Matters
  - Document Searches (pursuant to MFIPPA)
  - Photocopies of Documents, including by-laws
- Photocopies or Printing of Documents Colour increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.

#### Legal

 Changed descriptions on Half Day and Full Day fees from "Attend Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) on Behalf of Applicant to Defend Decision of Committee of Adjustment /

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Attend OMB on Behalf of Owner In Defence of Zoning By-law" to "Attend Court or Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) in support of Applicant on Decision of Staff or Committee under Delegated Authority / Council / Committee of Adjustment / in Zoning By-law matters, Heritage By-Law matters or other proceeding".

#### Museums:

• COVID-related pricing has been introduced in 2021 to reflect changes in how programming is being provided to Provincial directives. This pricing will remain in effect until pandemic-related restrictions are removed. If the restrictions are lifted prior to the end of the year, a fees and charges amendment will be brought to council for approval.

### Grand Theatre:

- Pricing for Kingston Non-Profit category expanded to include Artists.
- COVID-related pricing has been introduced in 2021 to reflect changes in service levels required in response to Provincial directives. The following rental rates will remain in effect until pandemic-related restrictions are removed. If the restrictions are lifted prior to the end of the year, a fees and charges amendment will be brought to council for approval.
  - Regina Rosen Auditorium, Non-Performance Use rate introduced to encourage local artists, non-profits and community groups to use the space to rehearse and/or create new work in keeping with Provincial directives and guidelines.
  - Baby Grand, 18-24 Seats depending on set-up rate introduced to reflect limited audience sizes allowed under Provincial directives and guidelines.
- Equipment and Staffing Piano Per Week rate for Kingston Non-Profit was reduced slightly to ensure fee harmonization between Non-Profit and Community Group rates.
- The following fees increased by slightly more or less than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes:
  - Security Commissionaire fees
  - Ticket Office Charges to Renter
  - Ticket Office Service Charges to Ticket Buyer
  - Subscription Handling Charge (per Subscription)
  - Capital Improvement Surcharges

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# Recreation & Leisure:

Rates, previously effective April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021, are now effective for the calendar year.

## Fitness Centres (INVISTA Fitness Centre and Artillery Park)

- Pool or Gym Membership (Cardio, Weight Room, Gym) includes new footnote to remove fees for Municipal Fee Assistance program (MFAP) users.
- Some fees were adjusted slightly more or less than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes, in order to maintain an appropriate fee structure in proportion to adult rates and/or to harmonize with other fees:
  - Pool or Gym Membership (Cardio, Weight Room, Gym)
  - Wellness Membership (Artillery Park Pool, Gym, Cardio/ Weight Room) (INVISTA Fitness Centre – Public Skating, Fitness Classes, Weight/Cardio Equipment)
  - Startup Membership Incentive Discount, All Inclusive Annual Membership Fit Pass
- Removed the All Inclusive 6 Month Membership SPARK reference to reflect changes to the Municipal Fee Assistance program and SPARK eligibility.

# Training

- Per Visit 1 Hour Personal Training (2<sup>nd</sup> Person Rate) increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.
- New footnote to remove fees for Municipal Fee Assistance program (MFAP) users.

#### **Outdoor Aqua Park**

- Drop In Day Pass, Drop in Evening Pass, 12 Visit Day Pass and Camp Fees per Visit rates remained the same to encourage use and to remain competitive.
- Drop In Passes for the Outdoor Aqua Park includes new footnote to remove fees for Municipal Fee Assistance program (MFAP) users.

#### **Other Fees**

• No change to per visit (swim, skate, gymnasium and shower) and 10 visit (skate or swim) for ease of cash management and promotion.

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- Membership card replacement increased slightly more than an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.
- Birthday Party Add a Child and Add a Caregiver fees were adjusted by more than an inflationary measure to reflect an appropriate fee structure in proportion to adult rates and to harmonize with other fees.
- Skate rentals no fee change or minor adjustment from an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.
- New footnote added for Toonie Swim, Skate or Gymnasium to remove fees for Municipal Fee Assistance program (MFAP) users

#### **Events & Programs**

- These fees are normally adjusted in range of inflation with consideration for ease of cash handling and harmonization between categories. The following represent fee adjustments that are other than the usual range of inflation.
- Increased Fitness 2 days per week per class rate by more than an inflationary measure to gradually align with 1 day per week rate.
- Camp Extended Supervision (per day/10-day program) rate increased by 15% to harmonize with Camp Daily Extended Supervision (per day) fee which remained at 2020 levels.
- Public skating fees adjusted for ease of cash handling fees held constant for Adult and Senior and Youth remaining fees increased greater than an inflationary measure to ensure appropriate fee structure between categories.
- New footnote added for public skating fees to remove fees for Municipal Fee Assistance program (MFAP) users.

# Artillery Park Programs

• Increased fees for Swim Lessons, Youth Levels 5-8 and Adult by slightly more than an inflationary measure for ease of fee collection.

#### **Rental Rates:**

#### Other Fees

• Staffing – Usher/Ticket Takers (Part Time Arena Operators) hourly rate increased by 75% in order to sufficiently recover respective staffing costs.

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#### **Rideaucrest Catering:**

• Some fees remained the same as they are sufficient to recover respective costs and, due to the size of the fees, will only be adjusted periodically by a multi-year increase.

#### Arenas:

- Arenas fees are effective July 1, 2021.
- Fees remained the same to encourage use and remain competitive.

#### Sports Fields:

• Increased fees for ball diamonds and soccer fields by 20% to reflect revised phase in of fee adjustments to acceptable market recovery levels.

#### Belle Park:

• Some fees adjusted by more or less than an inflationary measure for simplified cash handling.

#### Marinas:

- No change to fees for Seasonal Mooring (per foot) to better align with market prices and remain competitive.
- The following fees increased less than an inflationary measure for cash handling purposes and/or to maintain harmonization of daily, weekly, and monthly fees. The monthly rate reflects a factor of 3 times the weekly rate and the weekly rate reflects 5 times the daily rate.
  - Monthly and Weekly Rates May, June, September and October (per foot)
  - Monthly and Weekly Rates July & August (per foot)
  - Daily Rates Unserviced Wall or Dock (July, August, per foot)
  - Daily Rates Serviced Wall or Dock (May, June, September, October, per foot)

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- Daily Rates Serviced Wall or Dock (July, August, per foot)
- Overnight Mooring Preferred Rate (per foot) and Regular Rate (per foot)
- No change to Hourly Rate for Day Docks at Confed or corresponding maximum daily fee to harmonize with on-street parking rates in the area.
- No change to fees for Ice as fee is sufficient to recover respective cost.

### Airport:

# Passenger Facility Fee (Per Departing Passenger)

- Passenger Facility Fee (per departing passenger) were reduced to 2019 rates in order to align with similar airports and remain competitive.
- **Surcharges** No change to AVGAS Fuel Surcharge (per litre) and Turbine Fuel Surcharge (per litre). Fees continue to be sufficient to recover respective costs.

### Motor Vehicle Parking Fees

• Short-term parking fees increased by slightly less than an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.

# Planning:

#### **Heritage Planner**

• Removed fee for Heritage Information – Confirmation Letter (Heritage Status) and replaced with Heritage Permit Application fee to better reflect services provided and recover respective costs.

#### **Other Miscellaneous Committee of Adjustment Fees**

• Notice to Cancel Public Hearing and Recirculation of Public Hearing Notice Fees decreased slightly to align with Remailing of Public Notice Fee.

#### **Miscellaneous Fees**

- No change to Photocopies or Printing of Documents Black and White as fee remains sufficient to recover respective costs.
- Photocopies or Printing of Documents Colour increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure for ease of cash management.

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- Revised Footnote 1 item (iii) wording from "Covered or uncovered porches, deck and stairs from 0 m to 1.2 m in height from finished garage to finished floor" to "Covered or uncovered porches, deck and stairs".
- Revised Footnote 3 wording from "planning fees" to "planning fees, engineering fees and legal fees".

# Engineering & Transportation Services:

The description for this group of fees has been changed from "Engineering" to "Engineering and Transportation Services" fees to more accurately describe the nature of fees collected and several fees have been reorganized or renamed to provide clarity and/or simplify the overall Engineering and Transportation Services fee structure.

### Parking:

The following fees remained the same in accordance with the pricing framework to ensure parking management objectives for the City:

- On Street Parking:
  - Meters and Pay and Display
  - Residential On Street Permits (in valid on-street residential permit areas):
    - Residential Permit Parking
    - Residential Permit Parking-No Driveway
    - On-Street Residential Accessible Parking Permit
  - o Other Rates by Lot
- Hourly Rates by Lot
- Event Rates by Lot

# Residential On Street Permits (in valid on-street residential permit areas)

• Added fee for Residential Visitor Permit Per Week.

# Hourly Rates by Lot

• Removed Chown Memorial Garage and Hanson Memorial Garage from Hourly Rates by Lot and Event Rates by Lot and added to Other Rates by Lot to allow for varying fees depending on time of day and to add a lost ticket charge to the schedule.

# Parking Space Rental Fees

• Added Per Hour rate for Contractors, Movers, Producers - Construction Projects, moving of furniture or goods, filming or other legitimate projects' as follows: 25%, 50% or 100%

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rounding up on the daily meter rate in the area, per space, based on occupancy in the area.

### **Electrical Vehicle Charging Stations**

• Level 2 and 3 Charging Station per hour rates remain the same as they are consistent with local and provincial market rates for L2 and L3 charging.

# Transit:

Transit rates have remained the same in accordance with the Kingston Transit Business Plan as outlined in Council Report Number 16-304. Rates are recommended to be reviewed and increased every three years. Transit rates were increased in 2020 and are due for review for 2023.

# Building & Licensing:

# **Building Permit and Related Fees**

- As per recommendations outlined in Administrative Policies Committee Report Number AP-20-028 (October 8, 2020), new Sewage System Permit Fees have been added in order for the City to adopt KFL&A Public Health's fee schedule and cover operating costs related to enforcement of sewage systems through permits and inspections.
- The following fees remain unchanged as they are sufficient to recover respective costs:
  - Conditional Permit Fee Minimum
  - Fence and Sign By-law Appeal (each)
  - Alternative Solution Proposal (per hour) and Minimum
  - Construction Prior to Permit Issuance and Minimum
  - Photocopies or printing of documents including Freedom of Information, per side, plus search fees
- The following fees increased by more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes:
  - Demolitions (each)
  - Photocopies or printing of documents colour

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## **Animal Registration**

• No fee changes to animal registration fees to encourage licensing activities.

### **Other Animal Related Fees**

• No change to Bylaw & DOLA – Additional Fee for Convicted Owner, as current fee continues to be appropriate to recover respective cost.

### **Business Licences**

• Added new fees for Pay Day Loans – Initial Licensing and Pay Day Loans- Annual Renewal in order to establish regulations for the licensing of payday loan establishments, in accordance with newly enacted provincial legislation.

### **Administrative Monetary Penalties**

- The following fees were added:
  - Screening officer appeal fee
  - Hearing officer appeal fee

# Solid Waste:

#### Garbage

• Garbage Bag Tags (each) have remained at \$2.00 in order to encourage proper disposal.

# **Disposal Fees**

- No change to disposal fees for aerosol containers, fluorescent lamps, oil per litre, miscellaneous organics and petroleum distillates/light fuels in order to encourage proper disposal; fees are sufficient to cover respective costs of disposal.
- Disposal fees for liquid industrial waste, compact fluorescent lamps (each), inorganic oxidizers, and pesticides increased by slightly more or less than an inflationary measure to maintain rounded dollar amounts for cash management purposes.

#### Fire and Rescue:

# Reports & Records

• Photographs per copy (print or digital) increased by slightly more than an inflationary measure for cash management purposes.

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### **False Alarms**

 No changes as fees are currently aligned with Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) rates.

### Unauthorized Burning

• Per Unit for each response rate increased by 15% to align with MTO rates.

### Non-Resident Responses

• Per Unit for first hour or part thereof and Per Unit for each additional half hour rates increased by 15% in order to align with MTO rates.

### **Rules for Determining Permit Fees:**

• Floor area of the proposed work is to be measured to the outer face of exterior walls (excluding residential attached garages) and to the centre line of party walls, firewalls or demising walls.

• In the case of interior finishes, alterations or renovations, area of proposed work is the actual space receiving the work, e.g. tenant suite.

• Mechanical penthouses and floors, mezzanines, lofts, habitable attics and interior balconies are to be included in all floor area calculations.

• Except for interconnected floor spaces, no deductions are made for openings within the floor area (e.g. stairs, elevators, escalators, shafts, ducts, etc.).

• Unfinished basements for single detached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings and townhouses are not included in the floor area.

• Where Demolition of partitions or alterations to existing ceilings are part of an alteration or renovation Permit, no additional charge is applicable.

• Corridors, lobbies, washrooms, lounges, etc. are to be included and classified according to the major occupancy for the floor area on which they are located.

• The occupancy categories in this Schedule correspond with the major occupancy classifications in the Ontario Building Code. For multiple occupancy floor areas, the Permit fees for each of the applicable occupancy categories may be used, except where an occupancy category is less than 10% of the floor area.
