The night market is to offer a dynamic and community-oriented outdoor market that presents a variety of high quality, locally produced handcrafted arts and crafts to local residents and visitors.

### **Eligible Vendors**

The Night Market is open for the sale of locally produced and processed crafted products from approved producers, processors and individuals. Resellers are not eligible.

Arts and Crafts shall be hand-made by the vendor using as much local material as possible and his/her own skill, artistry and training to produce a new, unique and original product appropriate for the night market.

All submissions will be juried to ensure that they are of high quality and to help us to create an exciting area to shop and explore!
