NOTES

There are **no listed or designated** archaeological features or heritage properties adjacent to the proposed trail along the west branch of the Little Cataraqui Creek. Subject lands fall within the area of archaeological potential as noted in City of Kingston archaeology master plan.

The proposed pathway will enhance the live-ability and accessibility of the immediate neighbourhood to and from the parks and school. The proposed trail connection considers the highlighted design considerations as noted above.
